## When will the 2026 National Leadership Conference occur?

This year's National Leadership Conference will be a one-day event on **Saturday, July 18th**. Programming will take place from 8 am until 5 pm. There will be an optional welcome party on Friday evening as well as an optional social following the conclusion of the day's programming on Saturday, for those who wish to attend.



The Conference will take place in sunny **San Diego, California** on the campus of the University of California, San Diego.

## How much does registration cost?

Registration will be **\$50** per attendee. The registration cost does not include travel or lodging.

## Will chapters be given any financial assistance with travel costs?

The Sorority is partnering with the Phi Sigma Rho Foundation to offer grants to chapters to cover costs associated with travel. Details to come.



## Will lodging be provided?


Attendees will be responsible for the cost of their own lodging. The Sorority is working to secure group housing for all attendees. All those who are interested in attending the National Leadership Conference should RSVP as soon as possible so we know how much housing will be required.

## What will programming include?

Programming will be focused on both leadership development and sisterhood. Unlike Chapter Officer Training, there will not be position-specific educational tracks, so any collegian member who is interested in attending will benefit from the offered programming and social opportunities..

## Are all chapters required to attend in-person?

**No!** In attempts to reduce costs incurred by chapters and to limit the amount of travel required, the Sorority has decided to localize the next three iterations of the National Leadership Conference. In 2026, 2028, and 2030 the National Leadership Conference will be limited to a specific region of the country. **All chapters located within the region hosting the Conference will be required to send a representative to attend in-person. Attendees from chapters outside of the host region are encouraged to attend, although in-person attendance is not mandatory.** There will be a mandatory virtual component that every chapter is required to attend.



*Chapters required to attend in-person in 2026: Washington, UCLA, Oregon State, UCSD, UC Berkeley, Arizona, Arizona State, Colorado, Boise State, UCSB, Wyoming, Utah*

Note: This is for upcoming National Leadership Conferences in 2026, 2028, and 2030 only. All chapters are required to send a representative in-person to each National Convention, including National Convention in 2027 in Minneapolis.
